



2.6.2 Attainment of Programme outcomes and course outcomes are evaluated by the institution

As mentioned in the earlier sections of SSR, the Program Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) are defined as per the guidelines of the National Board of Accreditation (NBA) and an Outcome-based evaluation system is observed by the Institute. While implementing the programmes with defined POs and COs, care is taken to fulfil the Mission and Vision of the institute.

For any outcome-based system achieving the attainment level of the POs, PSOs, and COs is a key parameter that plays a vital role. This facilitates the development of academic culture among the students. Every program has its own monitoring concerns which monitors attendance, teaching-learning process, assessment of the students keeps the track of overall academics.

Course outcome attainment is calculated based on direct and indirect assessment methods.

If CO attainment = 6 out of 10

Rubrics:

If 50% of the students crossed 6/10 of the marks: Attainment Level 1

If 60% of the students crossed 6/10 of the marks: Attainment Level 2

If 70% of the students crossed 6/10 of the marks: Attainment Level 3

Direct attainment calculation = Direct Internal (40%) + Direct External (60%)

Indirect Assessment Methods:

Course End Survey: This survey was taken from students after their course commencement.

CO attainment = Direct attainment calculation (80%) + Indirect attainment (20%)

Program Outcomes Attainment calculation:

Overall POs attainment level = Direct POs attainment (80%) + Indirect POs attainment by Program End survey (20%)
