- To provide learning aids required for disabled students.

### **Action Plan:**

- To ensure adequate building design
- To ensure special arrangements in the examination of disabled students
- To provide exceptional support to learners with disabilities
- To ensure an ecosystem in which physically challenged students should not be discriminated
- To stop providing unique opportunities to the disabled





## Recommended facilities:

- Providing space for mobility devices like wheelchairs, Walkers, etc.
- Attention should be given to the dimensions of wheelchairs used locally.
- To build Ramps
- provision of Lifts
- To provide a scribe facility for the person who requires human assistance during the examination and academic activities.
- To provide screen reading software to the blinds (Installation of NVDA Software)
- To assist at the gate to help the disables
- To publish messages to help the disables
- To implement the necessary facilities per the guidelines of Govt. of India when required.
