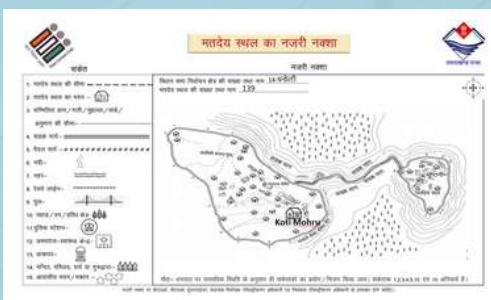


## THDC-IHET, Tehri

### Report on Preparation of Najri Naksha under SWEEP

Under the Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SWEEP) program of the Election Commission of India, Najri Naksha (polling station vicinity maps) were prepared for polling stations in Dhanaulti Legislative Assembly Constituency to support voter awareness and accessibility during elections. The objective of this work was to help voters easily identify polling stations and understand surrounding routes and landmarks.

The Election Department provided Google Maps screenshots with polling stations already marked. These maps were used strictly as reference material. Based on the provided images, approximately 150 hand-drawn Najri Naksha maps were prepared. Each map was created by carefully interpreting the relative positions of roads, habitations, pedestrian paths, and nearby landmarks. Standard Election Commission-approved symbols were used to ensure uniformity and compliance with official guidelines. The maps were designed for clarity and simplicity, focusing on relative location and connectivity rather than exact scale or geographic precision, making them suitable for public display and easy understanding by voters. The prepared Najri Naksha maps played a role in improving voter convenience, particularly for first-time voters, elderly citizens, and individuals unfamiliar with digital map applications. In recognition of this contribution, an appreciation certificate was awarded under the SWEEP initiative on the occasion of the 16th National Voters' Day by the District Administration, Tehri Garhwal.

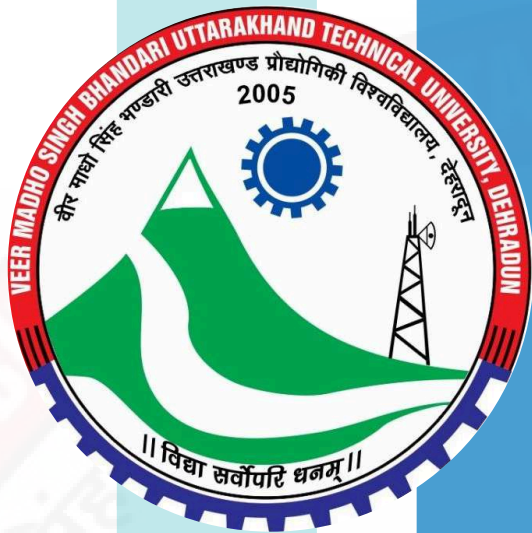
